EUROPE FOR NOTARIES, NOTARIES FOR EUROPE EU REGULATION ON SUCCESSION

The EU regulation on succession (applicable since 17 August 2015) revolutionized cross-border successions and therefore also the notarial activity on this field (probate proceedings, regulations regarding the applicable law, enforcement of rights in the inland and abroad as well as preventive financial planning under the law of succession).

It is of particular concern for the partners of the project “Europe for Notaries – Notaries for Europe” (co-funded by the European Commission) to thoroughly inform the notaries about this new regulation. Hence, the speakers will present the new legal situation in all its principles and discuss practical cases with the participants. Particular attention will be given to the national implementation of the following member states: Bulgaria, Croatia, France, Malta, Romania, and Italy. Paolo Pasqualis will illustrate, together with David Boulanger, the general principles of the regulation and the new rules directly affecting the national legislations.

Lilyana Tinkova, Tena Hoško, David Boulanger, Paul Pisani, Dan Andei Popescu, and Dario Restuccia will continue the discussion providing further details on the interpretation of the regulation and presenting some specific aspects concerning the national law of Bulgaria, Croatia, France, Malta, Romania, and Italy. Particular attention will also be given to some aspects related to the countries that opted-out the EU regulation. For that reason, we invited Karl Dowling (Irish barrister, author of the handbook on Irish succession law) who will explain the issues associated with Ireland not being a signatory and how notaries in other member states can orient themselves in the Irish legal system. Moreover, in order to have a better awareness of the reasons behind the law changes and the citizens request for legal services, Antonio Cappiello will present some basic principles of economic analysis applied to succession law. In fact, principles of economic analysis may play an important role in the EU regulation choices as well as in the specific planning of each private succession.

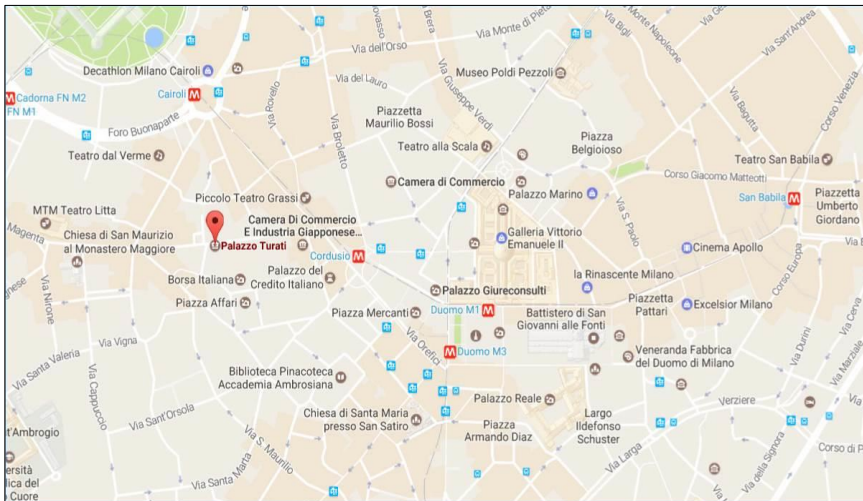
